**Music Culture Focused on Education** is a bachelor degree study field in the frame of study programme Specialization in Pedagogy, organized in the form of double-subject-studies (option of combination with another subject) in the full-time form of study.

**Profile of graduates and their prospective employment:**

Graduates have acquired professional knowledge in the sphere of music history, music theory, harmony, polyphony, musical forms, analysis, organology, music for children, PC music, music pedagogy, music sociology and music psychology. Graduates have also gained practical skills of playing the particular music instrument, singing and choir conducting. They will be prepared for studying the Master's degree programme "Teaching at Secondary Schools – Specialization in Music Education".

<b>Duration:</b>	3 years (= 6 semesters/terms)
<b>Language:</b>	English
<b>Price per semester:</b>	2000 EUR

**Organization of studies:**

Autumn/Winter term: 13 weeks from 3<sup>rd</sup> week of September + examination period

Spring/Summer term: 13 weeks from 2<sup>nd</sup> week of February + examination period

**Admission procedure:**

Application deadline: 31<sup>st</sup> March (for starting studies in September)

Completing of secondary school studies (the applicant must provide a certificate to prove that). The applicant is supposed to show developed music abilities such as intonation, sense of rhythm, musical memory, tonal feeling. Knowledge of the elementary music theory and the advanced performing level of playing the piano or violin (viola) are expected.

The applicant is supposed to provide a letter of motivation: his/her qualifications, instrumental/voice level, achievements, study motivations and expectations should be included.

Applicants have to send:

- a copy of their certificate of completing the secondary-level of education translated into English and verified by a notary,
- a letter of motivation in English (3600 letters),

No additional entrance tests will be administered, no oral examination.

Maximum possible rating: 100 points

Minimum boundary for admission: 50 points
