Teaching at Secondary Schools – Specialization in Music Education is a master degree study field in the frame of study programme Teaching at Secondary Schools, organized in the form of double-subject-studies (available only in combination with another study field) in the full-time form of study.

Profile of graduates and their prospective employment:

Graduates are fully qualified as secondary school music teachers or teachers of theoretical subjects at Basic Artistic Schools. They have been provided with adequate music theory and history knowledge as well as with instrumental and vocal skills, they are able to apply modern teaching methods and follow contemporary music pedagogy tendencies and trends.

Duration:	2 years (= 4 semesters/terms)
Language:	English
Price per semester:	2000 EUR

Organization of studies:

Autumn/Winter term: 13 weeks from 3rd week of September + examination period
Spring/Summer term: 13 weeks from 2nd week of February + examination period

Admission procedure:

Application deadline: 31st March (for starting studies in September)

A bachelor's degree in music culture focused on education or in a similar study programme is required.

The professional knowledge of music history and theory, of harmony and polyphony, of music forms and analysis, organology, music for children, PC music, music pedagogy, music sociology, music psychology, and practical skills of playing the chosen instrument, singing and choir conducting are expected.

The applicant is supposed to provide a letter of motivation: his/her qualifications, instrumental/voice level, achievements, study motivations and expectations should be included.

Applicants have to send:

- a copy of their bachelor's degree diploma presented in English and verified by a notary
- a letter of motivation in English (min. 3600 letters),

No additional entrance tests will be administered, no oral examination.

Maximum possible rating: 100 points

Minimum boundary for admission: 50 points
